"Dead Men Made Alive"

Ephesians 2:1-5

OUR SPIRITUAL CONDITION BEFORE/APART FROM SALVATION THROUGH JESUS CHRIST. v.1-3

- 1. We were spiritually dead. v.1
- 2. We were 'living' in alignment with the world. v. 2a
- 3. We were 'living' in alignment with spiritual darkness. v.2b
- 4. We were 'living' in alignment with the lusts of our body and mind. v.3a
- 5. By our nature (not just our actions) we were children of wrath. v.3b
- → This describes everyone before our salvation through faith in Jesus Christ.

THE WRATH OF GOD REMAINS UPON EVERYONE WHO DOES NOT HAVE SALVATION IN CHRIST.

- John 3:36: Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.
- Ephesians 5:6: Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.
- 1. Pleading ignorance will not save you. Romans 1:18-20; Acts 17:21; 2 Timothy 3:7
 - 'I truly just didn't have enough evidence to convince me that Jesus was the Savior.' 'I remain unconvinced.'
 - 2 Timothy 3:7: "always learning and never able to arrive at a knowledge of the truth"
- → Have you ever considered the arrogance of your ignorance?
- 2. Morality will not save you. Matthew 23:1f; 2 Timothy 3:5
 - 'I'm a very moral person—and I'm religious too!'
 - Many religious people in Jesus' day were very moral people. Pharisees, Sadducees, scribes, priests. Mt 23:1f
 - 'having a form of godliness but denying its power' 2 Timothy 3:5
- 3. Sorrow will not save you. 2 Corinthians 7:10-11
 - 'I truly feel bad about my sin.'
- 4. Good works—even in 'ministry'—will not save you. Matthew 7:22-23; Romans 3:10
 - · 'I'm very involved in church activities and charitable causes.'

BUT GOD... v.4-5

- 1. There is a way of escape! "But God..." v.4a
- 2. ...being rich in mercy... v.4b
 - Mercy = not getting the judgment (wrath) we deserve
- 3. ...because of the great love with which he loved us... v.4c
- 4. ...even when we were dead in our trespasses... v.5a
- 5. ...made us alive together with Christ... v.5b → Dead men made alive!
- 6. ...by grace you have been saved... v.5c
 - Grace = getting something good we do not deserve
- → What has man contributed to his salvation so far? NOTHING
- → You cannot make yourself born again.
